

Exemplars In Governance & Sustainability

Corporate governance and sustainability are the foundation of success for any public-listed company (PLC). They help to promote accountability, ethical growth and long-term resilience while driving positive social and environmental impacts. That is why the Minority Shareholders Watch Group (MSWG) introduced the National Corporate Governance & Sustainability Awards (NACGSA) this year, assessing a staggering 854 PLCs on Bursa Malaysia. They used a comprehensive framework combining the ASEAN Corporate Governance Scorecard (40%), the Malaysian Code on Corporate Governance (30%), and a sustainability assessment from Bursa Malaysia and MSWG (30%).

On 26 September 2024, IOI Corporation Berhad (IOIC) and IOI Properties Group Berhad (IOIPG) were honoured as top performers at the NACGSA 2024, held at the Mandarin Oriental Hotel in Kuala Lumpur. Out of 854 PLCs evaluated, IOIC scored an impressive 9th place, taking home the Overall Excellence Award 2024 (Top 10) and the Industry Excellence Award 2024 (Plantation). Meanwhile, IOIPG claimed the 21st place and bagged the Excellence Award 2024

Malaysia is committed to transforming its cities into low-carbon cities, aiming for liveable, vibrant spaces where we can enjoy cleaner, cooler and healthier environments. In 2011, the Green Technology and Climate Change Corporation initiated the Low Carbon Cities Framework (LCCF) under the Ministry of Natural Resources, Environment & Climate Change. They accelerated the nationwide transformation through the LCCF 2030 Challenge to establish 200 Low Carbon Zones and 1,000 Low Carbon Partners by 2030.

IOI Pan-Century Oleochemicals Sdn Bhd and IOI Edible Oils Sdn Bhd have been key partners with the Pasir Gudang City Council (MBPG) to reduce greenhouse gas emissions since 2016. Not only that, our Johor plants are located in the LC Pasir Gudang Zone 1, which is an LCCF Diamond-certified Low Carbon Zone.

On 27 July 2024, we were among 20 companies recognised by MBPG during the Festival Dinamika Hijau Pasir Gudang 2024 held at Pasir Gudang, Johor, for our sustainability efforts such as installing rainwater harvesting and solar thermal systems at our plants. These initiatives contributed to MBPG's mission and reduced 2,693,688.97 tCO2e of citywide carbon emissions in 2023. Together, we're showing how corporations and city councils can work hand in hand to achieve a greener future.

Leading In Mill Compliance

When untreated effluent gets dumped into waterways, it can damage our aquatic ecosystems, pollute the air and land, and create serious health risks. That's why at IOI Plantation Services Sdn Bhd's Mayvin Mill, we've consistently maintained our biochemical oxygen demand level below 20 ppm in our effluent discharge, installed electrostatic precipitators to keep particulate

matters below 150 mg/m³, and constructed suitable storage facilities to manage scheduled wastes safely. All these efforts are in line with the Environmental Quality (Scheduled Wastes) Regulations 2005, and they have been helping us manage effluent, air pollution and wastes in a way that promotes sustainability and reduces our environmental impacts.

On 20 June 2024, the Sabah Department of Environment (DOE) conducted a rigorous assessment upon Mayvin Mill with on-site verification and detailed documentation review. Not only did we pass their stringent requirements, but we also stood out from over 130 palm oil mills in Sabah. On 10 July 2024, we were honoured with the Best Compliance Palm Oil Mill in Sabah award for 2021 to 2023 during a seminar attended by all the palm oil mills in Sabah.

General Manager Mr Raymond Herbertson attributed the success to our people on the ground and said: "This recognition is a testament to the hard work and dedication of the team, who have consistently strived to exceed industry standards and minimise our environmental impact. IOI mills remain committed to continuous improvement and will continue to be a shining example of sustainable palm oil production."



Three months after our Prime Minister's announcement to make Malaysia a global semiconductor powerhouse during the *KL20 Summit* in April 2024, IOI Properties Group Berhad (IOIPG) is turning our nation's ambition into reality. We have been selected after a meticulous selection and extensive evaluation process among the locations in Klang Valley. We are partnering with Selangor Information Technology & Digital Economy Corporation to design the largest innovation hub for designing our own integrated circuits (IC) in Southeast Asia. The *Malaysia Semiconductor IC Design Park* was launched at our Puchong Financial Corporate Centre (PFCC) Tower 4 in Bandar Puteri Puchong on 6

Spanning 60,000 square feet, it will be the first of its kind in Selangor with facilities such as affordable electronic design automation tools, servers, intellectual property, multi-project wafer services and training programmes. Our primary goal is to promote original design manufacturing, encouraging local involvement in product design, prototyping and production to shift from 'Made in Malaysia' to 'Made by Malaysia'. The park is designed to house over 400 IC design engineers, and is now fully occupied with global semiconductor players including MaiStorage, Skyechip, Weeroc, AppAsia ChipsBank and SensoremTek Sdn Bhd. IOIPG is proud to contribute towards a more innovative and forward-looking nation!



The Amazing Race To Sustainability

This year, Master Shifu's words from Kung Fu Panda - "If you only do what you can do, you will never be more than who you are" - served as the key motivator to spur 41 go-getters, aged 21 to 40, as they dived into an environmental race against time! From 22 to 24 July 2024, the 28th Environmental Education Race (EERace) led the participants, including teachers and representatives from IOI Plantation Services Sdn Bhd and other eco-driven companies, on an adrenaline-pumping race to smash through 80% of outdoor challenges, hands-on learning, team efforts and fun, environment-themed tasks.

The main base of the course was at the scenic Rainforest Discovery Centre in Sepilok, Sandakan. At Mayvin Group plantations, we led the participants on a hands-on adventure with our best sustainability practices, from the thrill of spotting wildlife during night patrols in the Tangkulap Forest Reserve, to planting beneficial plants, clearing invasive weeds, protecting riparian reserves, managing waste and completing a fun hash run.

A collaboration of efforts among like-minded organisations such as IOI, the Sabah State Education Department, the Sabah Wildlife Department, the Bornean Sun Bear Conservation Centre and others, the *EERace* is a unique environmental education programme under the Sabah Forestry Department's Heart of Borneo Initiative which continues to make a positive difference. Once again, we donated RM3,000 to cover accommodation, meals and transportation, ensuring participants could fully engage in learning and practising environmental conservation.



Sunny Power On The Rise

Picture this: the sun delivers enough energy in just one hour to power the entire world for a full year because the sun is giving us an amazing 173,000 terawatts of clean, pollution-free and carbon-neutral energy every day. Solar panels can be integrated into existing heating systems to boil water or feed additional energy into heating circuits. The sun's abundance and adaptability make solar energy an ideal and long-term source of renewable energy for powering industries and households.

At IOI Pan-Century Edible Oils Sdn Bhd (IOI PCEO), we have relied on steam-heated tanks to maintain our storage temperature consistently above 60°C to prevent product solidification. But in our mission to become more sustainable and energy-efficient, we have decided to harness the sun's limitless energy. We replaced steam with solar-generated hot water for heating. By using solar thermal collectors to heat water, combined with generated heat from fuel gas through the economiser, we are creating a more eco-friendly system. Now for those rare times when the sun is not shining, we will use the fresh low-pressure steam from our existing boiler as a backup. It's an innovative, energy-smart solution that helps us stay on track with our sustainability goals!



On 23 July 2024, we reached another milestone in our sustainability journey by installing 70 sets of solar thermal collectors with 210 tubes on the rooftop of IOI PCEO's administrative building. This system is capable of delivering 2,014 watts of estimated peak output to our heating system, marking our second renewable energy project after successfully commissioning the 58.5 kWp solar photovoltaic panels in June 2024. By switching to solar thermal energy, we're not only reducing our reliance on fossil-based natural gas in conventional boiler systems but also significantly lowering our carbon emissions by approximately 200 tCO₂e annually. This transition to renewable energy aligns with our commitment to supporting the Malaysian government's efforts to reduce the negative environmental impacts of conventional energy production, transportation and consumption. We are proud to be playing our part in helping our nation build a greener future!

IOI Mall Puchong is also tapping into the sun's daily gift. By the end of next year, the mall will feature a car park solar panel system to soak up the sun while providing shade for all vehicles. We will be installing 3,799 solid black solar photovoltaic panels across our mall, from the rooftops on the South Wing right up to the North Wing.

Spanning more than 10,000 square metres, this solar power system will generate over 2,300 kWp of renewable energy to power our mall's lighting and other electrical systems. This eco-friendly upgrade not only reduces reliance on conventional energy but also underscores our commitment to sustainability, offering a greener, more eco-conscious shopping experience for our patrons.



Over the next 25 years, this solar-equipped car park will help us remove 49,894 tonnes of CO₂ emissions from the atmosphere.

Growing With Kebuniti Madani

More *Kebun Komuniti* or *Kebuniti* are growing and popping up all over Malaysia, making community gardening and sustainable living more accessible than ever. IOI Properties Group Berhad is proud to support this government-led initiative to allocate community gardens within neighbourhoods. We have designated a gardening haven right next to the *Perumahan Komuniti Johor* and *Rumah Mampu Milik Johor* in Taman Kempas Utama, Johor as a vibrant communal space for sustainable agriculture.



With a little help from the Johor Agriculture Department, our local residents have planted 160 pots of nutritious greens, including *pak choy, kailan, sawi, serai* and lettuce, in the sustainable garden. These nutritious vegetables provide a sustainable source of fresh produce for the B40 neighbourhood. Our *Kebuniti* not only bolsters food security and nurtures social connections, but it also promotes healthier lifestyles and sustainable living. It's a great step to create a lasting impact in the communities we serve.

Our community farm is designed to be

self-sustaining, powered by solar energy and

harnessing rainwater for irrigation in our

hydroponic system.



Malaysia receives abundant rainwater so why don't we harvest it and put this natural resource to good use? Instead of relying on the RM10,000 per month of local water supply from Syarikat Bekalan Air Johor (SAJ), Segamat Estate decided that it was time to invest in a rainwater harvesting system.

We have successfully transformed an old tank (*below*), measuring 41 x 20 x 15 feet (length x width x height) with a total storage capacity of 12,300 cubic feet (348 cubic metres), to collect, store and reuse rainwater. Not only have we removed our reliance on SAJ and saved on costs but we are now using the rainwater for various purposes, from cleaning and maintenance to gardening and spraying. It's an environmentally friendly and sustainable method that keeps things running smoothly.

The tank, filled with rainwater containing nitrates to aid plants to thrive, is used for watering oil palms and other beneficial plants as well as other purposes.



IOI Edible Oils Sdn Bhd has relied on our highly dependable cooling tower to ensure smooth and efficient operations at the Palm Kernel Dry Fractionation Plant (PKDF) 2. But when our cooling tower started to decline, we knew it was time to get an upgrade. The infills showed signs of deterioration and the wood-based hot water basins were no longer operating efficiently.

Hence in May 2024, we replaced it with a new cooling tower, building on the successful electricity savings we had already achieved with the one installed at PKDF 1 back in February 2023. Our new cooling tower consistently lowers the water temperature to 27-29°C, down from the previous 31-33°C. It has also reduced the electricity consumption of the chiller unit by 6%, dropping from 129 kW to 121 kW.

We have also optimised the size and position of the new pipelines to minimise pressure loss from multiple bends. By relocating them to a lower level and moving the return water header closer to the new cooling tower, we have made the system more efficient. Even more remarkable, the new cooling tower has slashed the overall electricity consumption by 68%, from 19.2 kW to just 6.1 kW. That is a huge energy saving!

Best of all, we are gaining our returns on investment from this energy-saving project in just 3.4 years while reducing an equivalent of 53,810 kg CO₂ of greenhouse gas emissions annually. Now that is a cool and impressive upgrade!

Tapping Into Tomorrow

Over at IOI Pan-Century Edible Oils Sdn Bhd (IOI PCEO), we have embarked on two water conservation projects to reduce operational costs and provide a resource-efficient future.



We installed rainwater harvesting systems across our IOI PCEO complex in July 2024, covering PC-I, Dry Fractionation, Consumer Pack, Distillation 1 and Hydrogenation II to harness the abundant rainfall in Pasir Gudang, Johor.

We are using the collected rainwater for our cooling towers and barometric cooling towers, which help us conserve around 1,000 m³ of tap water annually. We even repurposed unused scrap tanks for rainwater collection instead of purchasing new units.

We redirected the unutilised steam condensate from our IOI PCEO Tank Farm, which was merely discharged for treatment in our effluent treatment plant, for reprocessing and reuse in our plant processes and heating applications in August 2024.

This initiative has significantly reduced our tap water and steam consumption, leading to lower operational costs and more efficient resource management.

It's easy to remember and even easier to practise! After enjoying your favourite fruit juice or milk, just rinse the used beverage carton (UBC). Then fit the straw back into the carton. Flatten it. Next, flip the sides up and flatten the carton. How hard can it be? Once you've mastered the 4F technique, it's time to spread the word to your friends and families. And that's exactly what IOI Plantation

Following the successful launch of IOI Plantation's UBC recycling campaign with Tetra Pak Malaysia in Peninsular Malaysia in October 2022, we expanded the initiative across the shore to Sabah. From 18 to 30 September 2024, we kicked off a series of morning briefings at community halls and during roll-call sessions across all 31 of our operating units in Sandakan, Sabah. This outreach covered 23 palm oil estates, four palm oil mills, town offices, the Sandakan regional office as well as the research department, geoinformatics system department and cluster offices. Our employees, community members and even school children rallied to make a difference through their active participation.





In Lahad Datu, Sabah, we launched our first-ever school programme on UBC recycling with 60 children and two teachers at Sekolah HUMANA Ladang Cantawan on 23 September 2024. The school initiative will continue extending to the remaining 14 HUMANA schools in the region over the next two weeks! Now, we're not only educating our employees, but also reaching out to local communities, empowering everyone to make recycling a part of everyday life.



Strengthening Biodiversity & Ecosystems

Since 2021, IOI Corporation Berhad's Sustainability Consultation Forum (SCF) has provided an annual platform for partners, civil society organisations and technical experts to innovate and create long-term, positive impacts across our value chain. This year, our 4th SCF on 1 August 2024 was no exception, bringing together more than 60 internal and external participants to discuss the critical issues of biodiversity under the theme of Addressing the Impacts on Biodiversity & Ecosystems



Moderated by Global Environment Centre in a hybrid format, the forum highlighted the alarming state of climate change and its profound implications to the environment and ecosystems. We took the opportunity to present our existing implementation of biodiversity, conservation and rehabilitation activities as well as our *Biodiversity &* Ecosystem Enhancement Guidelines, which encompasses a four-step approach to identify, manage, monitor and strengthen our conservation efforts, ensuring the sustainability of our operations. We also adopt a landscape approach that fosters knowledge transfer and multi-stakeholder collaboration for a more sustainable future. Together, let's make a difference!

Conserving Our Gentle Giants Through The Ages

For millions of years, there were once 175 species of elephants roaming our earth. Today, we are down to just three: the Asian elephant, the African forest elephant and the African Savanna elephant. Sadly, even these remaining species are facing an alarming decline due to poaching, human-elephant conflicts (HEC) and widespread encroachment into their habitats. The rapid loss of these majestic giants not only threatens their survival but also disrupts the balance of our

To shine a light on the plight of these magnificent creatures, IOI Plantation Services Sdn Bhd (Sandakan Region) teamed up with the Sabah Wildlife Department (SWD) for World Elephant Day on 26 September 2024. The event, held at Ladang Desa Talisai in Beluran, Sabah, carried the theme Personifying Prehistoric Beauty, Theological Relevance, and Environmental Importance to remind the public of just how important elephants have always been.

As a long-term strategic partner of SWD in protecting wildlife, we have actively demonstrated our commitment and support to conserve these gentle giants. We have installed electrical fencing and erected signboards to minimise HEC, and have been organising awareness programmes for our workers

and neighbouring estates to educate the community on wildlife protection. We are also a member of the HEC Committee for Ulu Muanad Beluran in Sandakan, Sabah, and we have 12 well-trained Honorary Wildlife Wardens working with SWD to safeguard wildlife within our Sandakan plantations. It is all about making sure these incredible animals continue to thrive for generations to come!

The landscape features hardy, drought-resistant plants that need minimal maintenance while supporting pollination and wildlife like bees, butterflies and birds. Our landmark tower and columns are made from Balau wood, a native species known for durability, longevity and resistance to weather and insects. Best of all, the entire site is powered by solar energy.

Our Lookout Point welcomes you. See if you can spot the evergreen Dracaena Draco trees, which are classified as Vulnerable on the International Union for Conservation of Nature Red List!

What's more? IOIPG has teamed up with Kloth Care to make recycling fabrics super easy for our 16 Sierra community! We have set up a convenient drop-off point where residents can discard




Engineering Minds With Cool Discoveries


Erin loves nasi lemak; it is her breakfast of choice. Pile on the sotong, sambal and rendang, and top it off with a frothy cup of teh tarik. Who can resist the delicious array of foods like curry laksa and char kuey teow? How about some keropok or pisang goreng? Or the late-night mamak sessions? The joys of life are tastefully endless, but these are some of the delights that are silently killing us. Is it any wonder that Malaysia has one of the highest rates of obesity and diabetes in Southeast Asia?

Nearly a fifth of the Malaysian population today is either diabetic, obese, or both. Diabetes is one of the four categories of non-communicable diseases (NCDs), which are the leading cause of death around the world. NCDs are chronic diseases that are not infectious to others but cause long-term health consequences. They are typically caused by genetic factors, unhealthy lifestyles, smoking and overconsumption of alcohol.

Uncovering The NCD Crisis

According to the World Health Organization, NCDs kill 41 million people annually, equivalent to 74% of global deaths. Cardiovascular diseases account for most NCD deaths, or 17.9 million people annually, followed by cancers (9.3 million), respiratory diseases (4.1 million), and diabetes (1.5 million). These four groups of diseases account for over 80% of all premature NCD deaths.

You may think that you are still young and that only older people get them, but NCDs can affect anyone at any stage of life, whether you are a child, teenager, mother, or grandfather. Every year, 17 million people die from NCDs before the age of 70, and in Malaysia, Erin is just one of the 84% of adults aged 18 to 29 years with diabetes who do not even know that they have diabetes.






Behavioural Goals
